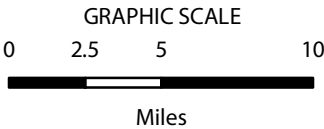


# Santa Barbara County Flood Control and Water Conservation District — Overview

The District was determined to not be a "District" (Per Gov. Code Section 56015 District Reorganization Act of 1965) by LAFCO Resolution 289, April 27, 1972.
