AMENDED PLAT OF THE DEPENDENT RESURVEY AND SURVEY

A history of surveys is contained in the field notes.

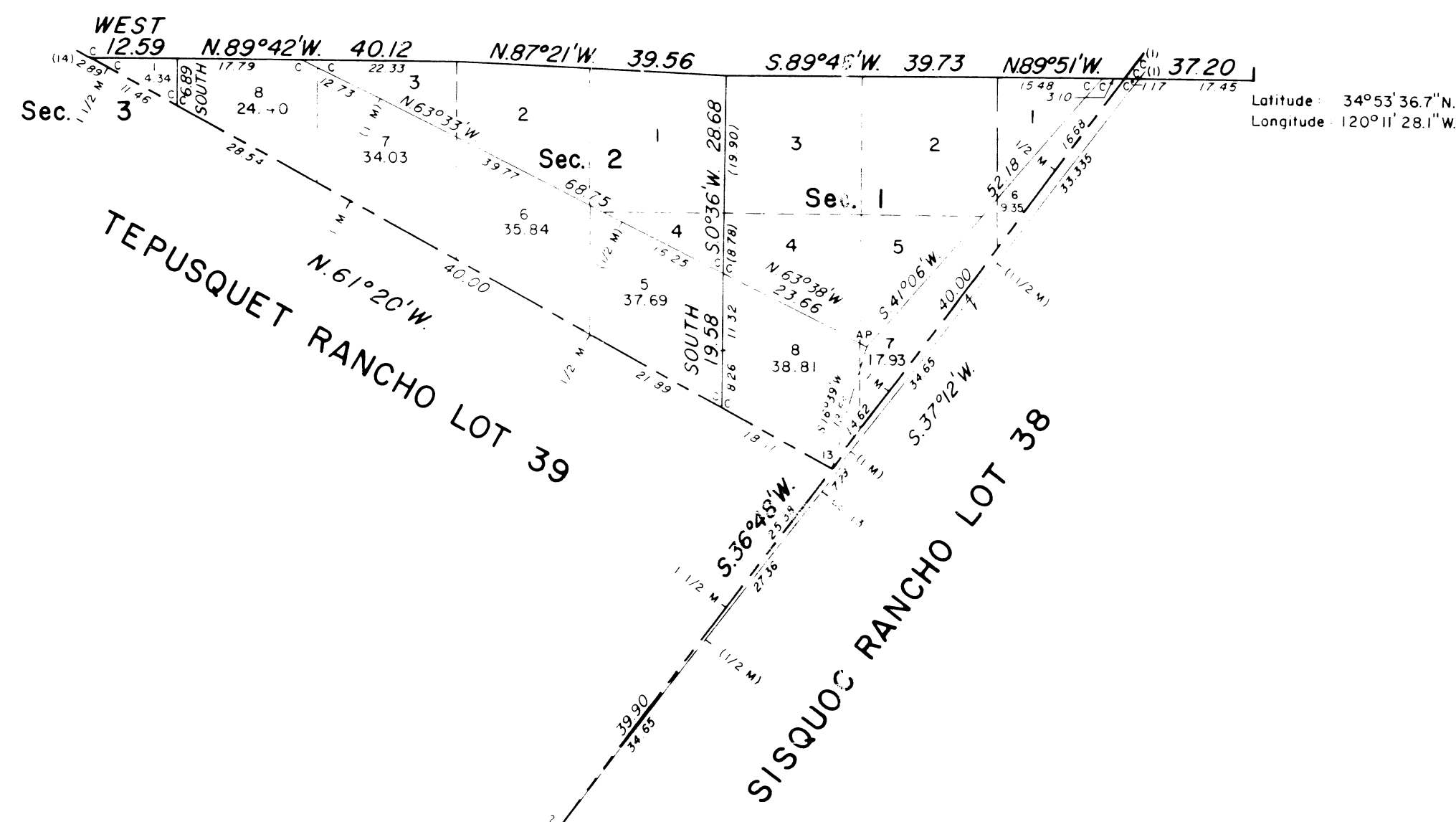
This plat represents the dependent resurvey of portions of the Tepusquet Rancho and Sisquoc Rancho, the limiting boundaries of fractional sections, and a portion of the exterior boundaries and subdivisional lines, designed to restore the corners of remaining federal ownership in their true original locations according to the best available evidence, and the extension survey and survey of a portion of the subdivisional lines of T. 9 N., R. 32 W., San Bernardino Meridian, California.

Except as indicated hereon, the lottings and areas are as shown on the plat approved August 5, 1901.

Survey executed by Jack W. Rabedew, Supervisory Cadastral Surveyor, beginning June 17, 1980, and completed September 10, 1982, pursuant to Special Instructions dated May 28, 1980, and Supplemental Special Instructions No. 1, dated May 20, 1981, and Supplemental Special Instructions No. 1 dated August 6, 1982, for Group No. 770, California.

Amendments executed by Jack W. Rabedew, Cadastral Surveyor, beginning June 1, 1988, and completed September 21, 1988, pursuant to Special Instructions dated May 27, 1988, for Group No. 1021, California.

Cautionary Note: The Bureau of Land Management has exclusive jurisdiction over all matters pertaining to surveys and resurveys affecting the public lands. As between owners of lands, the title of which has passed from the United States, final determination in the matter of fixing the position of disputed land boundaries rests with the local courts of competent jurisdiction. During the course of this survey, substantial evidence was observed indicating that lines of private ownership are not coincident with section and section subdivision lines established by this survey. This survey is intended to establish lines of federal ownership only, and should not be relied upon to establish boundaries between private owners without additional independent investigation.



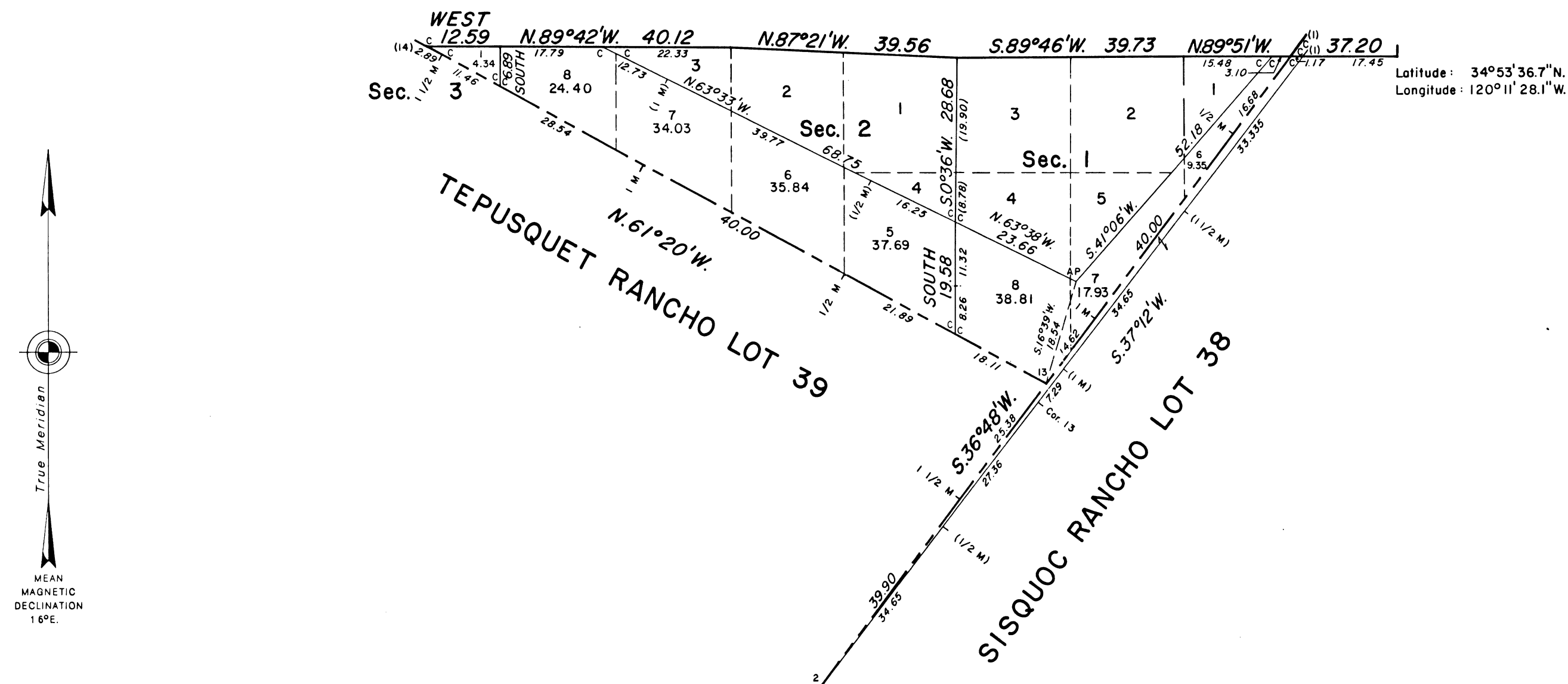

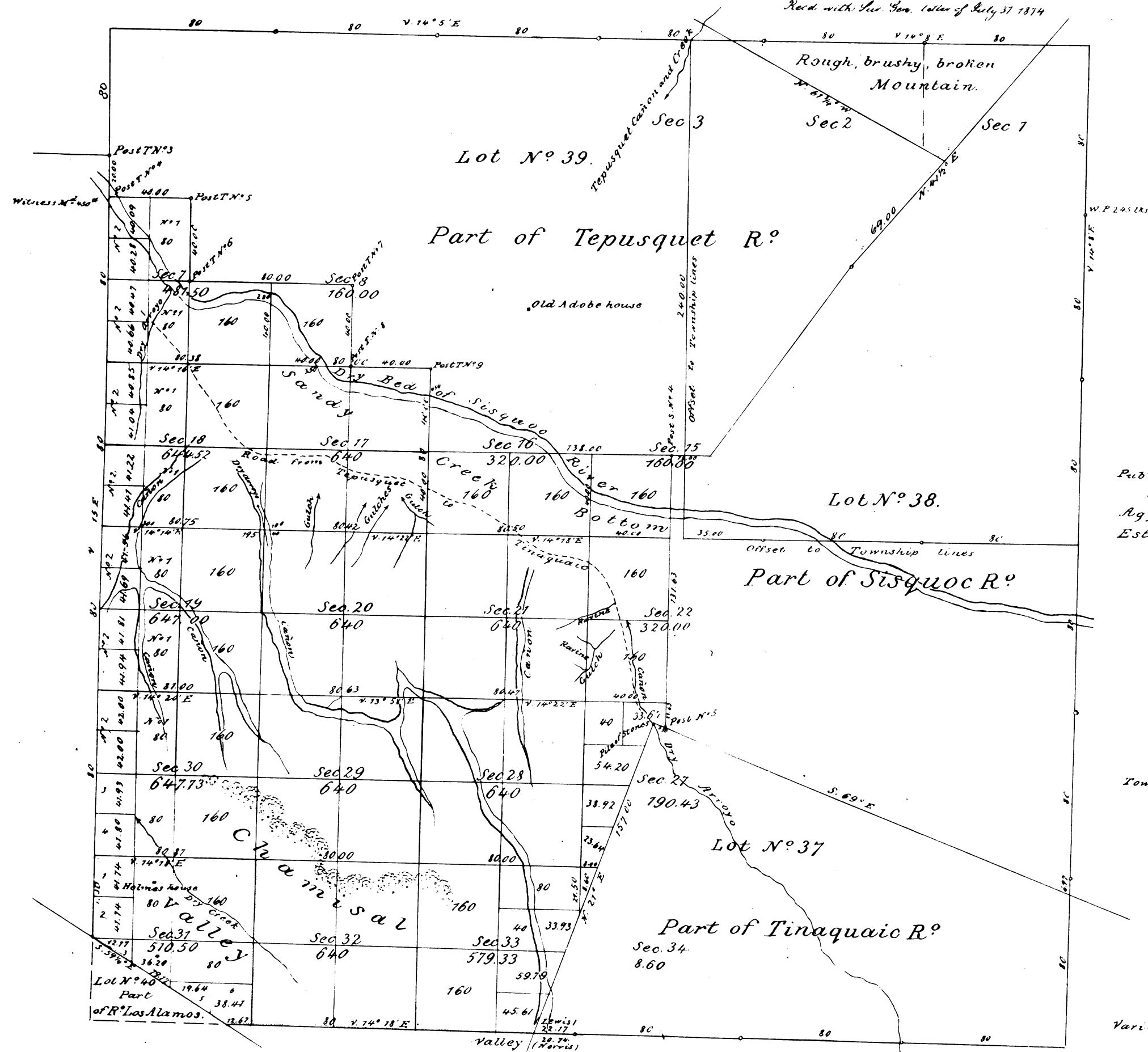
